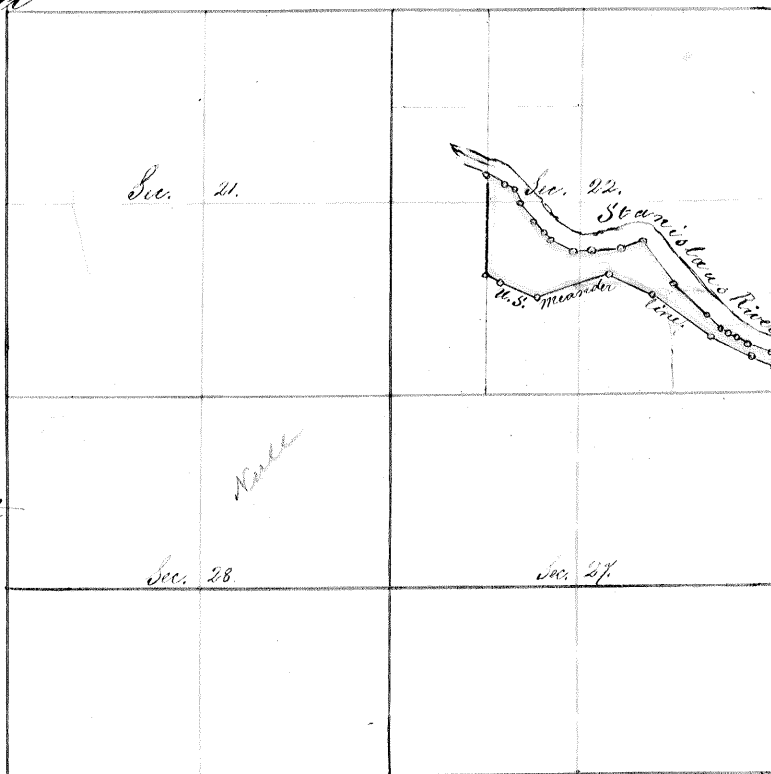

Beginning at a Post set at the intersection of the North and South line between the East  $\frac{1}{2}$  and West  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 22 T.2 S. R. 9 E. of Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, with the left bank of the Stanislaus River, thence meander up stream, S  $58^{\circ}$  E 5.00 chs., S  $28^{\circ} \frac{1}{4}$  E 2.00 chs., S  $13^{\circ}$  E 3.00 chs., S  $28^{\circ}$  E 5.00 chs., S  $40^{\circ}$  E 2.50 chs., S  $27^{\circ}$  E 2.50 chs., S  $53^{\circ}$  E 4.50 chs., S  $31^{\circ}$  E 3.50 chs., N  $81^{\circ} \frac{1}{2}$  E 6.00 chs., N  $60^{\circ} \frac{1}{2}$  E 5.50 chs., S  $4^{\circ} \frac{1}{2}$  E 12.00 chs., S  $44^{\circ} \frac{1}{2}$  E 11.00 chs., S  $59^{\circ}$  E 3.00 chs., S  $50^{\circ} \frac{1}{2}$  E 2.00 chs., S  $53^{\circ} \frac{3}{4}$  E 1.50 chs., S  $66^{\circ}$  E 4.00 chs., S  $71^{\circ} \frac{1}{2}$  E 7.01 chs., to a Post set at intersection with the East boundary of Section 22, thence South 3.68 chs. to a Post, set at intersection with the U.S. Meander line, thence along the U.S. Meander line down stream, N  $56^{\circ} \frac{1}{2}$  W 6.50 chs., N  $60^{\circ}$  W 9.24 chs., N  $54^{\circ} \frac{3}{4}$  W 15.00 chs., N  $67^{\circ}$  W 10.00 chs., S  $74^{\circ} \frac{1}{2}$  W 16.00 chs., N  $64^{\circ}$  W 7.78 chs., N  $50^{\circ} \frac{1}{2}$  W 3.34 chs., to a Post and Mound set at intersection with the Kanelo Line between the East  $\frac{1}{2}$  and West  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 22, thence North 21.80 chs. to the point of beginning.

Run by the true Meridian: Magnetic Variation  $15^{\circ} 30'$  East.

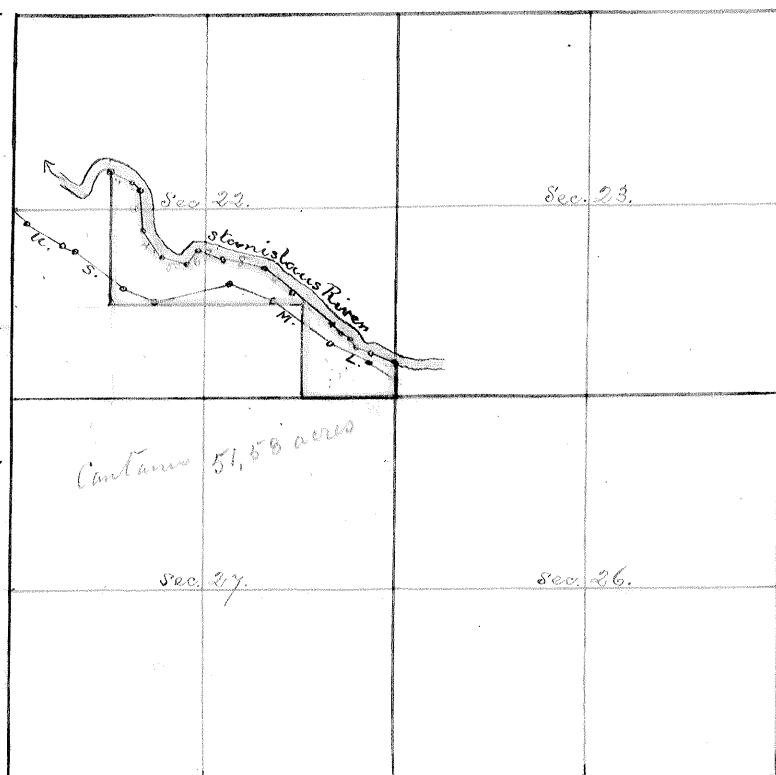
