The World's Smallest Skyscraper, which stands only 40 feet tall, was built in 1919. This structure is known as the Newby-McMahon Building.

This structure is notable for its cast-iron element and iconic red brick structure.

The structure was built after a confident trickster promised to construct a skyscraper in Wichita Falls. It took some time, and after completion, it was dubbed the "World's Littlest Skyscraper" because the majority of people saw it as a running gag.
