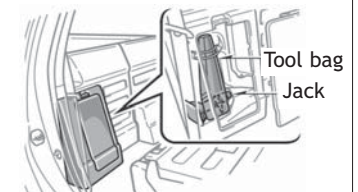

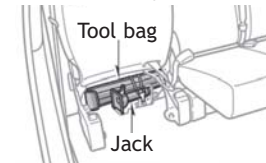

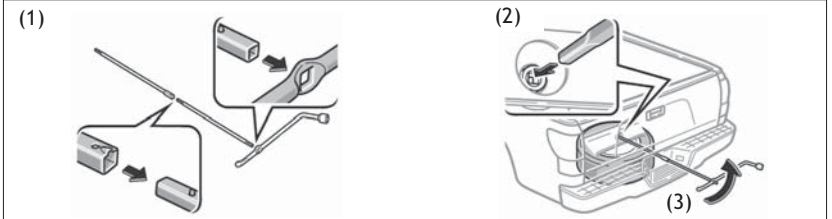

Downshifting increases power going uphill, or provides engine braking downhill. For best fuel economy during normal driving conditions, always drive with the shift lever in the "D" position.

Automatic Air Conditioning

A line drawing of the automatic air conditioning control panel. It features four circular knobs and several buttons. Numbered callouts (1-11) point to specific controls: 1 points to the fan speed knob; 2 points to the 'AC' button; 3 points to the driver's side temperature knob; 4 points to the 'AC' button; 5 points to the airflow vent knob; 6 points to the windshield airflow button; 7 points to the front passenger side temperature knob; 8 points to the 'DUAL' button; 9 points to the outside rearview mirror/back window defogger button; 10 points to the fresh or recirculated cabin air button; and 11 points to the climate control 'OFF' button.

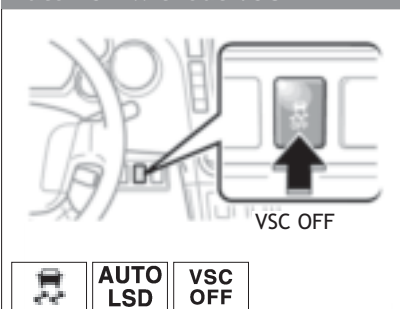
Auto LSD (Auto Limited Slip Differential)

Auto LSD with VSC



Briefly pushing the "VSC OFF" switch activates/deactivates Auto LSD with VSC. Vehicle speed must be under 62 mph.

Auto LSD without VSC



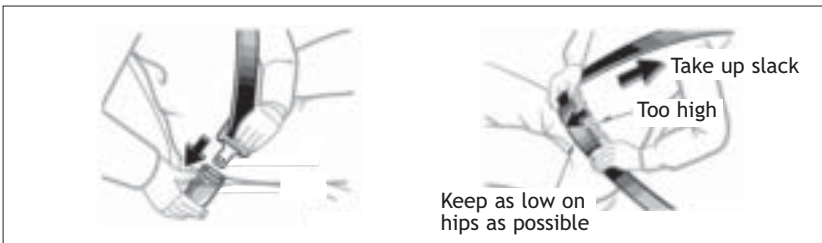
Push and hold "VSC OFF" more than three seconds to activate Auto LSD without VSC. Briefly push again to deactivate the system. Vehicle must be stopped.

Note: ONLY works in 2-wheel drive mode. Should ONLY be used when wheel spinning occurs on slippery or unpaved surfaces. Pushing and holding "VSC OFF" for three seconds activates VSC and deactivates Auto LSD.

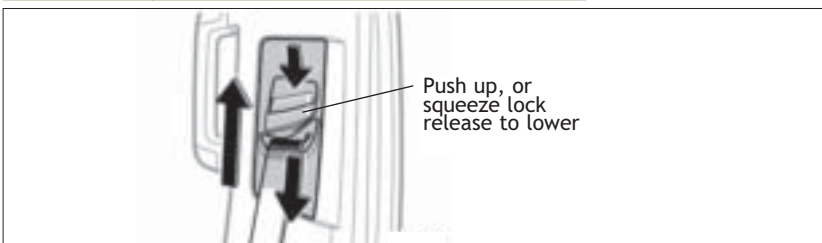

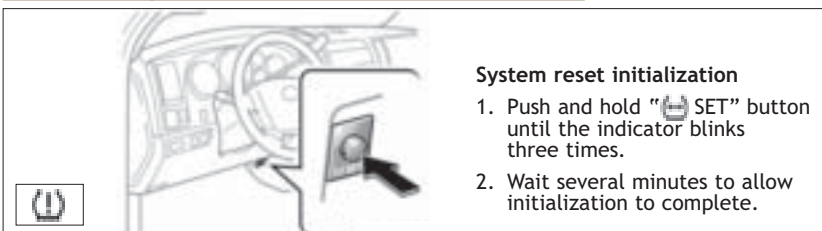
If belt is fully extended, then retracted even slightly, it cannot be re-extended beyond that point, unless fully retracted again. This feature is used to help hold child restraint systems securely.

Tire Pressure Warning System



If tire pressure becomes critically low on any of the tires (excluding spare), indicator illuminates. Pushing "SET" button should not turn off the light. Correctly adjusting tire inflation will turn off the light after a few minutes. After replacing/rotating tire or wheels, the system must be initialized.
