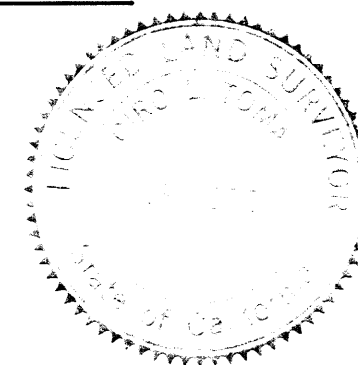


# PARCEL MAP NO 1303 for FRED BAKER
